FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENTS:

Department of General Surgery is providing O.P.D. services from Monday to Saturday from 09:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

There are 150 Beds for our Indoor patients, and 10 beds in the Surgical Intensive Care Unit (SICU). There are 06 beds in Burn ward situated separately & managed by competent Plastic Surgeons.

We are serving traumatic and non-traumatic Surgical Emergency cases (24X7) with all time dedication.

We are routinely performing General Surgery operations with conventional and Laparoscopic techniques/methods as well as other minimally invasive procedures.

Round the clock services for compliance with various national programs are available.

Basic oncological services are provided to cancer patients.

Our Urological services are at par with best tertiary care centers; we are performing:-

- Optical Internal Urethrotomy for urethral strictures
- Ureteroscopy for ureteric stones
- TURP for Prostatic Enlargement
- PCNL for Kidney stones
- Reconstructive Urology for vesicovaginal fistulae, stricture urethra and urethral caruncle.
- Pediatric Urology- management of congenital malformations e.g. posterior urethral valves, hypospadias etc.
- Complete stone management (conventional and endoscopic).

- Male infertility management.
- Excellent reconstructive and Plastic Surgery Procedures-
- Skin Grafting
- Flap Surgery
- Hand Surgery
- Surgery for congenital defects – cleft lip
- cleft palate
- hypospadias
- Syndactyly. Etc.

ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES:

Above all this Post Graduate Department of Surgery is running two-tier teaching in surgical know-how, with disciplined students and well-seasoned faculty for M.B.B.S. & M.S. Courses. M.B.B.S. students are taught with lectures, clinics and demonstrations with group discussions. Our department combines excellence in clinical cases. Clinical research is carried out after being daily approved by the ethical committee of the college and education of advancing fields of Surgery.

During O.P.D. hours, specialty clinics run concomitantly and residents participate in procedures. Our senior residents, after passing M.S. (Surgery) course, participate in camps for a social cause. Our department is the seat of learning for post-graduation in Surgery. Six students seek admission every year for M.S. Surgery and pursue three years' course under learned professors.

Our residents are very industrious during pursuance of M.S. (Surgery). There are eighteen residents working diligently in this department, six for each year of three-year course.

24/7 emergency duty provides an opportunity to become a team member and provide emergency care to patients who report in emergency department. They have done excellent work in the ongoing Covid -19 pandemic.
