## **ELIGIBILITY & EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS FOR M.B.B.S. COURSE (2022-23 SESSION)**

### **ANNUAL INTAKE:**

The Institution has an annual intake of Recognized 150 M.B.B.S. Seats vide Letter No. **No.U.12012/224/2015-ME.I[FTS.3101873]** Dated: 05.05.2017 from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India

### **ADMISSION CRITERIA:**

All the seats are allotted through State Government Counselling organized by Director General Medical Education, Lucknow as per the merit secured in National Eligibility Cum Entrance Test (UG).

### **ELIGIBILITY & EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:**

1. Eligibility for appearing in NEET (UG) is as stipulated in Indian Medical Council Act-1956/Regulations as amended in 2018 Regulations as amended in 2019.
  - a) He/She has completed age of 17 years at the time of admission or will complete the age on or before 31st December of the year of his/her admission to the 1st year M.B.B.S Course.
  - b) The upper age limit for NEET (UG) is 25 years as on the date of examination with relaxation of 5 years for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category and persons entitled for reservation under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

#### **The Age Criteria of appearing in NEET (UG) 2022 is as follows:**

For Candidates of Unreserved Category (UR)	Born on or Before 31.12.2005
For Candidates of SC/ST/OBC/PH Category	Born on or Before 31.12.2005

2. The candidate must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology/Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/ Biotechnology at the qualifying examination. In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 50% for General candidates. Further, for persons for locomotors disability of lower limbs, the minimum of 45% marks for General-PH and 40% marks for SC-PH/ST-PH/OBC-PH are required.
